



Spectator Areas (ZE)

ZE 1 – Portalegre (39^a 14.758N / 07^o 27.506W)

Location: Near Driving License Centre in Portalegre (IP2)

Description: Water line passage with a jump just before the end of the stage.

Access: Close to Portalegre, by IP2 (km 179), walking access (approx. 300m).

Car parking: Near IP2, follow instructions ZE1.

ZE 2 – Seda / Alter do Chão (39^o 11.532N / 07^o 47.792W)

Location: Ribeira de Seda (road connecting Seda to Vila Formosa and Vale Barqueiros).

Description: Mythical crossing of the Ribeira de Seda. Good visibility.

Access: Coming from the South, by Avis, follow EN 370 towards Alter do Chão. Bear in mind that circulation will be conditioned before the village of Seda.

Coming from the North, by Ponte de Sôr or Alter do Chão, follow the direction Galveias and Avis, on EN 370.

Once in Seda, follow the signs ZE2.

ZE 3 – Ponte de Sôr (39° 16.301N / 08° 01.289W)

Location: Industrial Area

Description: Artificial area with good visibility. Sandy track with good accesses.

Access: Near Ponte de Sôr, follow Zona Industrial and ZE3 signs

Passing times

1st Bike SS3 (km 120) – 11h30

ZE 4 – Domingão (39° 15.250N / 08° 23.570W)

Location: Next to Domingão football field

Description: Two passes in two distinct but very close circuits.

Access: Next to Ponte de Sor, next to EN2, follow the signs for ZE4.

ZE 5 – Foros do Arrão (39° 10.786N / 08° 13.861W)

Location: Foros do Arrão / Ponte de Sor

Description: Natural area with some turns and good visibility.

Access: Coming from Abrantes, in Bemposta, follow directions to Chaminé, Ádua Travessa, Gorjão and Foros do Arrão. The EN 367, connecting Foros do Arrão to the EN2, will be closed to traffic. Coming from the South, or Ponte de Sor, follow directions to Montargil and them to Foros do Arrão. ZE4 is located....

1ª Moto SS3 (km 147) – 11h40

ZE 6 – Gavião (39° 27.758N / 07° 56.364W)

Location: In Gavião

Description: Natural area with some turns and good visibility.

Access: Coming from the North, take A23, leave at Mouriscas or Portalegre (IP2), and follow the signs to Gavião (EN 118). Turn left in the 1st exit to Gavião.

Coming from the South, by Ponte de Sôr or Portalegre, follow the EN 118 to Gavião and Abrantes, and turn left in the 1st exit to Gavião.

1st Auto SS3 (km 124) – 09h15

1st Bike SS3 (km 243) – 12h50



ZE 7 – Tolosa / Nisa (39° 25.396N / 07° 43.906W)

Location: Near the village of Tolosa.

Description: Artificial zone with good visibility.

Access: From the IP2, near Tolosa, follow Comenda direction. About 600m after IP2 follows by the left by dirt road direction ZE7. After 1500m you will find the ZA7 on the right.

Passage times

1st Auto SS3 (km 175) – 09h35

1st Bike SS3 (km 295) – 13h20

ZE 8 – Monte da Pedra / Crato (39 22 004N / 07 44 844W)

Location: Monte da Pedra Football field.

Description: Artificial area with a hairpin, some corners and one jump.

Access: There are several accesses to this village: from IP2, through Gafete, follow the signs Monte da Pedra. From Portalegre, via Crato, follow the signs to Monte da Pedra.

1st Bike SS3 (km 304) – 13h30

ZE 9 – Crato (39° 17.830N / 07° 39.975W)

Location: Near the Swimming Pool complex

Description: Arrival of the event for Autos (SS3). It is a partially artificial spectators area, around 3 km long. This area offers several good viewing points for all sequences.

Access: From Portalegre, or Ponte de Sor, use IC13 and follow directions to Crato and Flor da Rosa.

1st Bike SS3 (km 325) – 13h45

ZE 10 – Comenda (Ribeira da Venda) / Gavião (39° 24.762N / 07° 48.025W)

Location: By the Pic-nic park at Ribeira da Venda.

Description: Traditional crossing of the Ribeira da Venda.

Access: From EN 118, follow signs to Comenda.

Passage times

1st Bike (Km 81) – 11h00

1st Auto SS4 (km 58) – 14h15



Roads closed to the traffic on October 27th:

- Municipal Road 1071, Terrujo / EN 370. Alternative through Seda and EN 370
- The Chancelaria pathway, connecting Alter do Chão to the Portalegre railway – both ways
- Municipal Road connecting EN119, Vila Formosa e Seda
- Municipal Road connecting Benavila to Vale de Seda

Conditioned roads on October 27th:

- National Road 370, Seda / Avis

Roads closed to the traffic on October 28th:

- Municipal Road 363, Crato to Aldeia da Mata (both ways). Alternative through Alter do Chão, or Vale do Peso, among others.
- National Road 369, Chança to Cunheira – both ways.
- The Chancelaria pathway, connecting Alter do Chão to the Portalegre railway – both ways
- Municipal Road connecting Alter do Chão to Aldeia da Mata – both ways.
- Municipal Road connecting Comenda to EN118 (through Venda water way)
- National Road 367, Foros de Arrão / EN2 – both ways.
- Municipal Road connecting Gavião to Amieira Cova – both ways.
- Municipal Road connecting Flor da Rosa to Aldeia da Mata

Conditioned roads on October 28th:

- EN 244, near Ponte de Sôr (more restricted from Gavião to Ponte de Sôr).
- N2, near Ponte Sor (exit to Domingão)
